1. Helped create a fun and energizing work atmosphere by overcoming my own shyness with humor and fun to motivate those around me to do the same. Leading to better communication and comradery

1. Lead the Frontend design of two major projects, providing a strong foundation that accelerated the rest development.
2. Exceeded client's expectation for the project's UI/UX by being vigilant to minor details and refining them to perfection and adding extra flourishes to improve overall experience.
3. Implemented a full plugin system, for both back and front-end, within a few weeks; that took a senior developer 12 months and produced no results, by applying simple but flexible design patterns.
4. Met customer's security needs for the application, by configuring the container stacks with Docker compose to ensure an "air tight" setup by removing exposed ports between services, to improve overall security and reliability.
5. Avoided a costly solution to a CORS problems between the main app and a 3rd party service's GraphQL API suite, by quickly implementing a bridge API to utilize the 3rd party services internally. Saving development time and money.
6. Fulfilled a desired user feature, by Implemented a data parsing backend API to translate the raw data output of a Tmux process to be displayed within the frontend web application, allowing the user to use Tmux comfort of a web interface.
7. Was the creator of many fun aspects of our company's lore and culture, especially being the reason behind why we can't have stickers on our laptops and "Fire-engine Fridays".
